Adelaide Casino Live Large Concert Series Saturday (March 3) Line-Up "The Race That Rocks" – 2012 Clipsal 500 Adelaide

Saturday night's **Adelaide Casino Live Large Concert Series** gig concert sponsored by The Adelaide Casino supported by **Radio Mix 102.3** is legendary to the extreme with the following acts.

INXS

One of the most notable and successful rock bands of all time, INXS have sold over 35 million albums worldwide with the group's music remaining in constant radio rotation and in DJ sets nightly across the globe. To this day, the group's multi-platinum landmark albums *Listen Like Thieves*, *Kick*, and *X* are all widely regarded as music collection staples. Huge chart-topping hit singles including *What You Need*, *Need You Tonight*, *Devil Inside*, *Never Tear Us Apart*, *New Sensation* and *Suicide Blonde* have been featured in numerous films, advertising campaigns and video games, earning the band countless accolades and awards around the world, including several Grammy nominations, and is the driving force behind selling over 15 million albums in the U.S. alone. With a career spanning three decades, INXS have created some of the most enduring music in rock.

INXS have received renewed worldwide critical acclaim following the release of their latest studio album **Original Sin**. Hailed as a "rewarding collision of nostalgia and modernism" and a "cleverly and lovingly assembled collection," **Original Sin** teamed the band with musicians from around the globe, from Ben Harper, Pat Monahan (Train) & Rob Thomas to Kav Temperley, JD Fortune, Loane, Dan Sultan, DJ Yaleidys and Tricky [Massive Attack] to reinterpret and revitalize their own classics for a whole new generation.

The album's first single, "Original Sin" featuring Rob Thomas and DJ Yaleidys, officially topped the Billboard Dance chart earlier this summer, knocking Britney Spears off the No 1 position. In Australia, the album hit Number Two twice on the iTunes albums chart. Ben Harper and Mylene Farmer's version of "Never Tear Us Apart" debuted at Number Four on the French iTunes charts, and "Mediate" featuring Tricky [Massive Attack] went Top 5 on the U.S. Billboard dance charts. In September, 2011, INXS announced Grammy award winning singer/songwriter Ciaran Gribbin as the band's new front man and have recently unveiled the first new demo recording with Gribbin, titled *Tiny Summer*. The band will continue to write and record a slate of new songs with Gribbin for a future new studio album release

MARK SEYMOUR & THE UNDERTOW

An Australian music icon as front man and lead singer for Hunters and Collectors, Mark Seymour (brother of Crowded House bass player Nick Seymour) has moved on Mark Seymour & The Undertow.

His song *Holy Grail* has become a sporting anthem but with The Undertow (Cameron McKenzie-Guitars, keys, vocals, John Favaro – bass, vocals, and Peter Hunter – drums, vocals) Seymour has written a new suite of songs including *Castlemaine*, *I know too Much About You*, *Sylvia's In Black*, *Legend Of The Snowman*, *Eldorado*, *Cry In The Rain*, *Classrooms And Kitchens*, *Give Me One More Ride*, and *The Red Lady's Gone* - a lament about his stolen '72 HQ Holden Monaro,

Critics have suggested that *Undertow* is possibly Mark Seymour's finest album.

YOU AM I

Tim Rogers formed the first version of the band with his school friend Nick Tischler and his older brother Jaimme in December 1989, but the initial line-up was short lived.

The band released several EPs and singles in the early 90s, though the real breakthrough came when Lee Ranaldo of Sonic Youth caught the band performing at the 1993's Big Day Out festival.

In 2010, it was announced that they had left EMI to sign with new Sydney label Other Tongues. Their ninth self-titled studio album is chock full of subtleties and surprises, from the controlled rocking grandeur of the first radio single *Shuck*, to the smoldering second radio single *Trigger Finger*, to the Beatles/Beach Boys beauty on *Waiting to be Found*.

The 2012 Clipsal 500 Adelaide is to be conducted from March 1-4 as the first event of the 2012 V8 Supercar Championship.
